



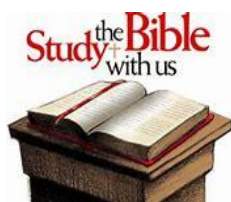

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is needed today more than ever. As we stand on our mission to *Spark Faith In Christ Jesus Through Time In Creation and Community* at UMM, we are called to continue in some new ways this summer. With the COVID-19 pandemic, UMM is making some changes to be able to do **MINISTRY NO MATTER WHAT**.

UMM has worked for months with local Health Department officials to engage recommendations by the CDC, North Dakota State Department of Health, and the American Camp Association. If your camper has any pre-existing medical conditions, please seek advice from your primary care physician for a recommendation on whether to attend camp in 2020.

Health Screenings

- Upon arrival at camp, all campers will have their temperature checked and will be asked whether they have had any COVID-19 risk factors or symptoms in the past 2 weeks.
- Temperature and symptom checks will be performed daily during camp

Physical Distancing

- Campers will be in close contact with others within their cabin group of 7 campers and one staff member.
- Camp activities will be modified to emphasize physical distancing between cabin groups

Meals

- Meals will be served family style, rather than buffet-style.
- Cabin groups will not perform the traditional "KP" duties of clearing tables, washing dishes, etc. These will be performed by designated staff members.
- Tables will be placed 6 feet apart from each other with a maximum of one cabin group at each table.

Hygiene/Cleaning

- We will promote good hygiene practices such as hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, refraining from touching your face, limiting unnecessary contact, etc.
- Cabin groups will have designated times each day for showering their private cottage showering spaces.
- Cabins will be disinfected once daily.
- Campers will sleep head to foot in bunks.
- Each camper will be given designated space to store their belongings.
- Common area restrooms will be cleaned by designated staff members 3 times each day.

Registration/Check-In

- Check-in at the start of the week will be "drive-thru" style. Campers and their families will drive through several check-in stations as they ultimately make their way to their cabins. Family members will be allowed to get out of their cars to help unload camper luggage and say goodbye. Families will not be able to visit the physical cabins this year.

Closing Worship

- We are still working out the details for closing worship. We will have a closing worship for our campers and staff prior to pick-up. This service will be recorded and made available to view online with a parental code.
- Those who come to pick up campers at check-out will be directed to drive-thru pick-up locations to get their campers and their belongings.

*But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart. And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.
(Luke 2:19-20)*

I have a treasure drawer in my bedroom. It's the place where I put my son's baby teeth, his first report card, Grandma's ring, my husband's naturalization flag. I look through these things every so often and remember. It's a way of connecting to the people I love.

It might have been harder for Mary to keep physical mementos of Jesus' birth. But she kept the memories and thought about them often. They kept her connected to God's great works of the past, both during the hard life as refugees in Egypt, and then later, during the quiet years in Nazareth. She remembered what God had done—and she looked forward to what He would do in the future.

For us who believe in Jesus today, that is what we remember and treasure: Jesus' birth among us, God with us; His life among us, serving the poor and broken; His suffering and death on a cross—all to rescue us from the power of evil; and His resurrection from the dead, which means that we, too, shall rise.

This is a God worth remembering—a God worth loving, worth treasuring everything we know of Him. Right now, we don't see Him face to face, and that's hard; but we can do what lovers do and look through the treasures He has left us—His promises, the Gospel story, Baptism, the Lord's Supper. The Holy Spirit will work in our hearts to keep us trusting and loving Jesus until we see Him again.

THE PRAYER: Lord, help me to remember and think on You with love. Amen.

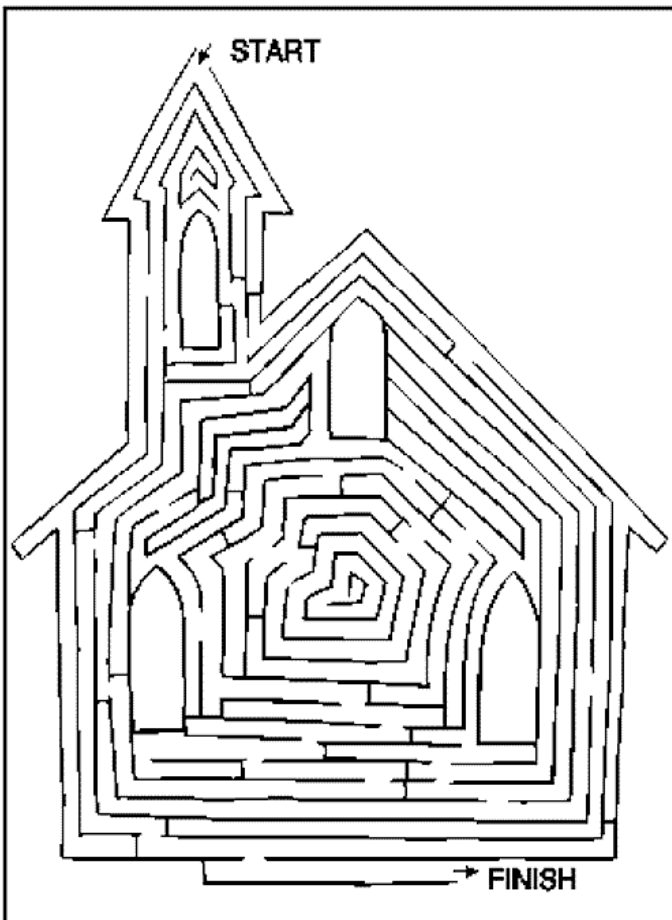
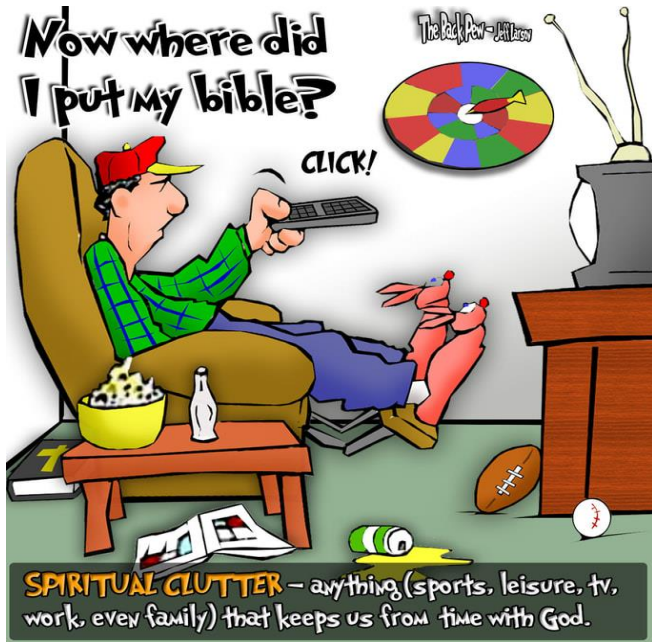
