
PASTOR SCOTT YOUNT



LUTHERAN HOUR MINISTRIES

DEVOTION from LHM.ORG

2 Timothy 1:5-7 - I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. For this reason, I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands, for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.

We just celebrated Mother's Day a few weeks ago. Among the many godly mothers and their sons mentioned in the Bible, Eunice and her son Timothy stand out. Timothy was a faithful friend and loyal assistant of the apostle Paul. Though a bit timid in temperament, Timothy joined with Paul on various missionary trips and had even been left in charge of the congregation at Ephesus.

Somewhere near the end of Paul's fight for the faith, he wrote the words in our text above to Timothy. Paul wanted to strengthen the faith and zeal of his young apprentice. He wanted to encourage him to be true and steadfast in what he had learned about Jesus: how He died for our sins, how He rose again to be our Savior, how He is coming back one day to gather all believers to share eternal life with Him.

In his travels, Paul had seen all types of circumstances in the people he encountered. He understood the effect people have on one another—both good and bad. "Bad company ruins good morals," he told the church at Corinth (1 Cor 15:33b), warning them of the dangers that lay ahead if they follow their current course.

But of Timothy's mother and grandmother, Paul speaks to the grace and goodness of a faith shared and encouraged within a family—how God uses it for achieving His own purposes.

It's a lesson for us today. Many are the influences our children will experience in the course of growing up. If what they find in their homes is but the simple reflection of what they see all around them, well, then theirs will be an uphill battle, to say the least. But when the home is centered in the love of Christ and His forgiveness, children are encouraged by this example. They are empowered by God's Spirit to live a life of faith, firmly grounded in His Word.

Paul understood the tremendous impact of one's upbringing when he wrote this to Timothy: "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 3:14-15). What a wonderful compliment from the apostle to those who raised Timothy!

WE PRAY: Heavenly Father, give us courage to express our faith in our households, loving our families as You have loved us in Jesus Your Son. In His Name we pray. Amen.

Council Meeting Minutes - Tuesday, May 9th, 2023

These minutes are abbreviated. If you would like the full minutes, ask a council member.

The meeting was called to order by President, Dwight Ebel.

The following members were in attendance, Dwight Ebel, Rick Tofte, Gary Hansen, Matt Haugen, Kayla Fenster as well as Pastor Kevin Beard. Wendy Johnson was absent.

<u>Pastors report</u>: Pastor Kevin advised that services at both churches are going well.

• Pastor has been volunteering a lot with Youth for Christ in the schools as well as having lunch with students. Lunch in the school will be coming to an end soon due to summer approaching.

Two new members, Kelly Klem and Janice Deesten have joined our congregation.

<u>Treasurers report</u>: Rick went over the financial report. As of the end of April the church currently has \$274,038.99 in savings/checking and that we are right on budget. Treasurers Report accepted.

Old business:

• AED: A motion for the church to go ahead and purchase the AED 3 as quoted previously and if the grant is received this money would go to reimburse the church. \$2,314.95 Approved. Stephen Ministries: We will approach and interview people that might be good as Stephen Ministers. This would take place in the fall and we will ordering books/materials soon.

Capital improvements:

• New furnace: the new furnace is here but won't be installed until the long Memorial Day.

- Aluminum doors: The doors have been ordered and will possibly be put in by the end of May.
- Wall/partition: There is no report yet for the sanctuary wall/partition.
- Trim work for the serving area and doors in the remodeled kitchen area have been installed.

New business:

- Daycare: The daycare is going well and appreciates the rent reduction the council approved.
- Daycare playground: Looking into grass alternatives for the playground area for the daycare that would be less muddy/ messy for the children. Looking into wood chips or pea rock.
- Altar paraments: Rick made a motion to purchase four (4) season paraments. We will continue to ask for donations.
- Women's clinic fundraiser: A pro-life group helping young women in all areas of pregnancy / birth as well as education about not getting an abortion. Council voted to support them.
- Annual AALC conference: Pastor Beard advised that the annual AALC pastors conference will be October 30th, 2023. The council will be assisting with the conference fee and mileage.
- UMM camp scholarships: The UMM summer camp that Pastor Beard will be assisting with will be July 30th thru August 4th for 3rd thru 9th grades. Council will pay 50% of camp costs.

Alley issues: The city will be taking care of the frost heaves in the North alley possibly May.

A motion to adjourn this meeting was made by Gary and seconded by Rick. Motion passed.

The next council meeting will be July 11th with meal provided by Bev Quale.


